### 2. RESERVATION FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED PERSONS:

2.1 As per G.R. Medical Education & Drugs Department No. MES 1202(81)/VaiSeva-1, dated 19th August, 2005 eligibility / Non-eligibility of sub-categories of Physically Challenged Candidates for the subjects is mentioned below and candidates who submit the certificate mentioning clearly such type of disability will only be considered for the posts

2.3 The reservation for Physically Challenged persons is as per Government Circular, Social Justice and Special Assistance Department, No. Apang-2007/C.R.61/Sudhar-3, dt. 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2007.

3. PAY : Rs. 15600-39100/- plus Grade Pay Rs. 6000.

### 4. AGE :

4.1 Not more than 35 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2010. Relaxable as per rules.

4.2 The upper age limit shall not apply to the employee of Government of Maharashtra.

4.3 Age limit may be relaxed by Govt., on recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidate possessing exceptional qualifications or experience of research, in the relevant subject, or both.

### 5. QUALIFICATIONS: 5.1 Candidates must possess ---

- 5.2 Preference may be given to candidates having experience of research work in the relevant subject.
- 5.3 All medical teachers must possess a basic university or equivalent qualification included in any one of the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956)
- 5.4 Medical teachers must possess the requisite recognised post-graduate medical qualification in their respective subjects.
- 5.5 The issue of availability / non-availability of the post for the non-medical science qualification holders shall be decided on the basis of the clarification received from the Government.
6. **DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:** The details regarding duties and responsibilities of the post is available on web site of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission.

**7. GENERAL:**

- 7.1 Selected candidates will be on probation for a period of two years.
- 7.2 For the unreserved post other things being equal, preference will be given to candidates belonging to the Backward Classes.
- 7.3 There are prospects of promotion to the post of Associate Professor in respective subject.
- 7.4 Selected candidates will be required to sign the agreement embodying the condition of their service including the condition to serve Govt. for a period of 5 years or to pay a penalty of Rs.10,000/- (Rs.Ten Thousand) or such other sum as may be prescribed by Govt.
- 7.5 Selected candidates should have to give one option whether to do private practice or to be paid non-practicing allowances in lieu according to the rules.
- 7.6 Selected candidates will have to get themselves registered under the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965. [Mah. XLVI of 1965] or his/her name should be borne on the I.E. Register under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. (CIA of 1956), before joining duty.

**8. NOTE:**

- 8.1 Column No.6.2 of the old application regarding 'Do your claim reservation' OR column No. 5.1 of the new application regarding 'Do you claim benefits of reservation such as Fee, Age and the post reserved for Backward Categories' shall stand deleted. However, the backward class candidates and general Female candidates belonging to the Non-Creamy Layer section will have to claim regarding NCL. In these circumstances, both the applications, old as well as new, submitted by the candidate, will be accepted by the Commission.
- 8.2 In addition the candidates should attach separate sheet of details of qualification, along with application form, starting from S.S.C., H.S.C. and year wise marks of degree and class etc. of each year as per column 21 or 31 in the application form. Specimen of preformed is available on the web site of Commission in 'specimen sheet of details of qualifications' section'.
- 8.3 The Commission at its discretion, may shortlist the applications for interview, based on reasonable criteria i.e. experience and/or higher qualification, etc. OR may conduct Written objective type Screening Test (multiple choice question) to shortlist candidates for interview. The syllabus and medium of question paper and other details for the test shall be displayed on the Commission's web site.
- 8.4 The prescribed essential qualification is the minimum qualification and a mere possession of minimum qualification does not entitle candidates to be called for interview where the number of application received in response to an advertisement is large in numbers and it will not be convenient or possible for Commission to interview all the candidates the Commission may restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualification and experience higher than minimum prescribed in the advertisement.
- 8.5 Copies of certificates should not be attached along with the Application Form. However, candidates are required to furnish an affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs.100/-, affirmed before a Notary in respect of correctness and authenticity of the information mentioned in the Application Form. Specimen of affidavit is published on the website in the "Specimen form of Affidavit for Direct Recruitment Posts" Section.
- 8.6 The Application Form should be accompanied by an affidavit, failing which it will be treated as incomplete & will be rejected.
- 8.7 The candidate should submit all the certificates at the time of interview as per instruction given in Chapter-4 of the Prospectus provided along with the application form.

- 9.1 Application must be submitted on the form supplied by the Commission for Direct Recruitment.
